Partnerships Against Foxes

Foxes are one of the worst invasive species worldwide. In Australia they are widespread in most environments. Foxes threaten over 95 nationally listed threatened species. Predation and diseases spread by foxes also impact livestock especially sheep, goats and poultry, causing major losses for landowners in some regions.

We are working to prepare a community-endorsed East Gippsland Remote Communities Fox Control Strategy, an important basis to guide future coordinated fox control actions in remote difficult-to-access areas such as the Upper Snowy. We want to work with East Gippsland communities and help to guide DEECA and Parks Victoria to approach pest control in a way that better suits everyone's needs.
